

**DECREE**  
**OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**  
**NO. 6 OF JANUARY 10, 2002**  
**ON MEASURES TOWARDS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UN SECURITY**  
**COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1373 OF SEPTEMBER 28, 2001**

In connection with the UN Security Council Resolution 1373 of September 28, 2001 under which acts of international terrorism pose a threat to international peace and security and which confirms the necessity to counter, with all means available, as is stipulated in the Charter of the United Nations Organization, the threats to international peace and security created by acts of terrorism, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. The federal state authorities and bodies of state authority of the subjects of the Russian Federation shall, in their activities and within the framework of their respective powers, proceed from the necessity:

- a) to prevent and put an end to the funding of acts of terrorism;
- b) to institute in conformity with the laws of the Russian Federation criminal liability for the intentional provision or raising of funds by any means whatever, whether directly or indirectly, by citizens of the Russian Federation or on the territory of the Russian Federation with the intent to use those funds - or with the knowledge that they will be used - to carry out acts of terrorism;
- c) to ensure an urgent freezing of funds and other financial assets or economic resources of persons who carry out or attempt to carry out acts of terrorism or are involved in or assist with the carrying out of acts of terrorism; of organizations, directly or indirectly held in ownership or under control of those persons and also of persons and organizations acting on behalf or by directives of those persons and organizations, including funds received or acquired with the help of property, directly or indirectly held in ownership or under control of those persons and related persons and organizations;
- d) to take measures to ban citizens of the Russian Federation or any other persons and organizations on the territory of the Russian Federation to provide any funds, financial assets or economic resources or financial or other relevant services, whether directly or indirectly, for the use in the interests of persons who carry out or attempt to carry out acts of terrorism or assist with or are involved in the carrying out of same, of organizations, directly or indirectly held in ownership or under control of those persons and also of persons and organizations acting on behalf or by directives of those persons;
- e) to undertake further activities in order to rule out the provision of support in whatever form - whether active or passive one - to organizations or persons involved in acts of terrorism, including by putting an end to recruitment of members of terrorist groups and by liquidating channels of supply of weapons to terrorists;
- f) to take necessary measures with the objective to prevent acts of terrorism, including by giving an early warning to other states through an exchange of information;
- g) to refuse an asylum to persons who are funding, planning, supporting or committing acts of terrorism or offering shelter to terrorists;
- h) not to allow persons who are funding, planning, providing assistance with the commission of acts of terrorism or are carrying out acts of terrorism to use the territory of the Russian Federation for those purposes against other states or their citizens;
- j) to ensure that any person involved in the funding, planning, preparation or commission of acts of terrorism or the support of acts of terrorism be brought to justice and also that, apart from other measures in respect of those persons, those acts of terrorism be determined as grave criminal offence under national state laws and provisions and that the punishment be proportionate to the gravity of such acts of terrorism;
- k) to provide competent authorities of other states with all-round assistance in connection with criminal investigation or criminal prosecution which are related to the funding or support of acts of terrorism, including the assistance in obtaining evidence available with them which may be required for such prosecution;
- l) to prevent the movement of terrorists or terrorist groups by means of efficient border control and control of issuance of identity and travel documents and also by employing measures to prevent falsification, forgery or illegal use of identity and travel documents.

2. The Ministry of Justice of the Russian Federation shall be required to undertake, jointly with other interested federal bodies of executive authority and with the participation of the Supreme Court of the Russian Federation and the General Prosecutor's Office of the Russian Federation an analysis of the legislation of the Russian Federation for its compliance with the commitments recognized in UN Security Council Resolution 1373 of September 28, 2001 and to submit relevant proposals within two months to the Government of the Russian Federation.

3. The Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Finance of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Justice of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade of the Russian Federation, the Foreign Intelligence Service of the Russian Federation, the Federal Border Service of the Russian Federation, the State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation shall, in accordance with their respective competence, provide, with the participation of the Central Bank of the Russian Federation, for the implementation of measures envisaged under this Decree, and as regards issues which are the competence of the President of the Russian Federation and the Government of the Russian Federation - submit proposals in the established manner.

4. The federal executive authorities mentioned in Item 3 of this Decree shall, with the objective to prevent acts of terrorism, be required:

- a) to conduct, as is stipulated by the international law and the legislation of the Russian Federation, an exchange of information with the competent bodies of interested states and cooperate with those bodies on administrative and judicial issues;
- b) to step up and accelerate an exchange of operational information, in particular, on actions or movements of terrorists or terrorist groups (networks); on forged or falsified travel documents, on trading in weapons, explosives or materials of double purpose, on the

use by terrorist groups of communication technologies and also on the threat posed by the possession by terrorist groups of weapons of mass destruction.

5. The Government of the Russian Federation shall present within two months' period a report on the progress of the implementation of this Decree.
6. The federal executive authorities mentioned in Item 3 hereof shall submit within two months' period to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation information on measures which have been or are being taken towards the implementation of UN Security Council Resolution 1373 of September 28, 2001.
7. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation shall keep the UN Security Council duly informed of measures taken by the Russian Federation to implement UN Security Council Resolution 1373 of September 28, 2001.
